Teacher Information

Classroom Teacher Role & Responsibilities

- Review New Hampshire Scholar information and determine appropriate pre- or post presentation activities.
- Have LCD projector and any other necessary equipment ready.
- Introduce Presenter (sample script below).
- Remain in class for the entire presentation to maintain classroom control.
- When the presentation is over, pass out and collect student evaluation forms.
- Complete teacher evaluation form.
- Offer Student Contracts for New Hampshire Scholars sign-up.
- Return evaluation forms to your school's New Hampshire Scholars Program Coordinator.

Agenda for Classroom Presentations (Approximately 50 minutes)

- Business speaker is introduced (teacher briefly introduces speaker). Please write speaker's name on board.
- Speaker introduces self (who, why here, job/position).
- Scholars PowerPoint Presentation and Question & Answers.
- Students and teacher complete their evaluations.
- Teacher collects student evaluations.
- Four-Year Planner offered to students as Program Contract.
- Teacher informs students that they can meet with school counselors to discuss and plan high school registration and select classes.
