# NH Scholars Yearly Timeline

## 2018-2019 Potential Activities

### Fall 2018

- Include NH Scholars messaging in first year orientation
- 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade Kick-off Assembly
- 12<sup>th</sup> grade confirm the student is still on track and take advantage of NH Scholars free application benefits and NH college scholarships
- 9<sup>th</sup> grade Make 4-Year Plan
- 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade review 4-year plan (*Fall & Winter*)
- Incorporate NH Scholars into program of study, website, etc.
- Create electronic indication on senior transcripts (*Sept/Oct*)
- Begin developing business partnerships
- Nominate a business in your community to be a NH Scholar Champion by November 1<sup>st</sup>
- Attend Business Education Breakfast Event for educators/businesses (*December 5, 2018*)

### Winter 2018-2019

- Host a “Sign on to Scholars” event. Use the NH Scholar sign on cards and encourage students to post photos of their sign on card to social media using the hashtags, #ImaNHScholar #NHScholar
- Reach out to business partners
- Send Year End Report of expected seniors to NH Scholars office (January/February)
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade Kick-off Presentation (*February/March*)
- Talk about NH Scholars in student advisories
- Business leader presentations

### Spring & Summer 2019

- Add NH Scholars topic to 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents’ nights
- Host a “Sign On to Success Day” to celebrate career or academic plans after high school.
- Attend Statewide Recognition Celebration (*May 23, 2019 @ NEDD Stadium, Manchester*)
- Senior Recognition Event to award medallions at your high school (*June*)
