Dear Mr. Power:

This letter details the agreement to make a one-time exception to the AP® Program's late-testing policy for students participating in the 2016 New Hampshire Scholars Day, which coincides with the 2016 AP Exam administration schedule for May 5th. You may share this letter with principals and/or AP Coordinators at schools where students are scheduled to attend this event.

The following accommodations will be made for students participating in the New Hampshire Scholars Day and still take advantage of AP Exams scheduled on the morning of May 5, 2016.

- Affected students may use the alternate date (Thursday, May 19 @ 8 a.m.) for the AP Calculus AB or BC exam offered on the morning of May 5.
- This exception to the late-testing policy only extends to those students attending the NH Scholars Day and who are planning to take the AP Calculus exam.

Note: The AP Program is extending this rare exception to our late-testing policy; however the decision to take advantage of this option is left to individual schools. Should the schools where these students attend refuse to administer exams on the alternate day, the AP Program will respect these local decisions. Schools should be aware that data from alternate exams are not included on the AP Instructional Planning Reports (a score report available to AP teachers), and free-response booklets from alternate exam are not available for purchase.

How to Order AP Calculus Exams for Late-Testing

- Schools opting to administer the AP Calculus exam during the late-testing period for affected students must order the alternate exams online.
- So that schools will not incur the \$45 surcharge routinely applied in cases such as these when the decision to test on alternate dates is a personal choice, schools should select as their reason for late testing "AP Approved" **for these students only.**
